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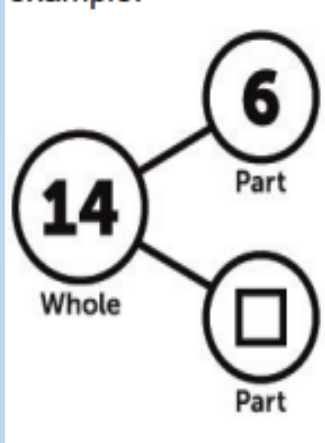

This term we will be learning how to use the inverse to help us add, subtract and find missing numbers.

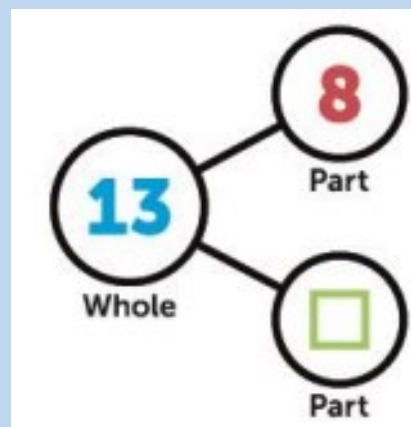
Can you write the inverse calculation showing the missing part?

$14 - 6 = \square$
is calculated by taking away a **part** from the **whole** leaving a **part**.
So the inverse will be adding the **parts** to make the **whole** so is
 $6 + \square = 14$.



$$13 = 8 + 5 \text{ and } 13 - 8 = 5$$

13 is the **whole**.
8 is a **part**.
 $\square$ is a **part**.
A **part** is the missing number.
