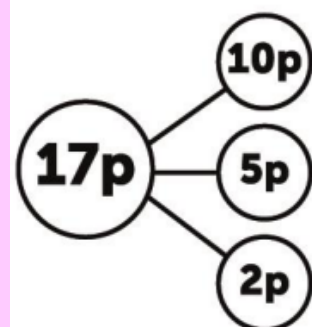

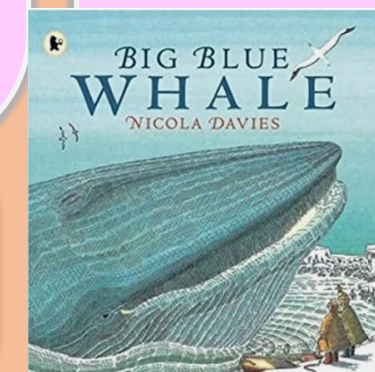
Key word	Meaning
