Amen.

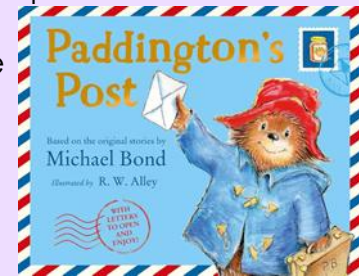

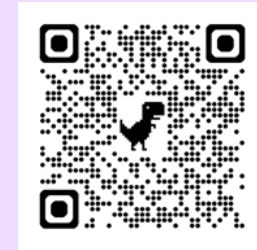


## English

We will be writing letters, using the text '**Paddington's Post**'! In this unit your child will learn to compose a sentence orally before writing it and use a capital letter for names of people and places. Children will be introduced to punctuating sentences using a question mark. They will also learn to use a capital letter for names of people and the personal pronoun 'I'. We will be spelling the days of the week & using a capital letter for the days of the week.



We will be investigating free verse, using '**Out and About**' by Shirley Hughes. The children will write sentences by sequencing sentences to form short narratives and use a capital letter for the personal pronoun I. Children will then write their own poems and read aloud their writing.



We will be returning to entertaining narratives by looking at **Little Red and The Very Hungry Lion** by Alex T Smith.

## RSE

We will be learning about "good" and "bad" secrets, physical boundaries, The NSPCC PANTS rule, harmful substances And what to do in an emergency situation.



## RE

We will be recapping the events throughout Jesus' life, then exploring what happened after he was crucified.

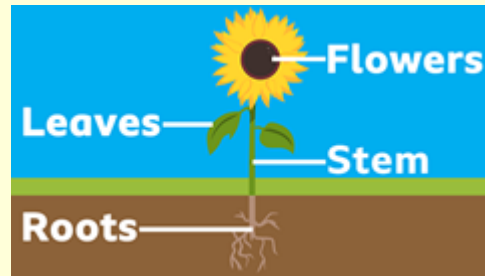
## Science

We are learning about plants this term. We will be looking at the parts of a plant, how they grow and where they can grow.

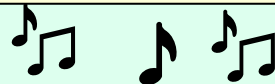
Key vocabulary: plant, roots, stem, stalk, bud, flower, leaves, bulb and seed coat
