

## DT-Tudor Houses

This term, the children will learn how to design and build their own Tudor-style house. They will explore the features of Tudor homes and practise key skills such as cutting, joining and strengthening materials. The children will plan their design, make their structure and then evaluate how well it worked.

- **Structure** – something that is built and stays upright.
- **Stable / stability** – how strong and secure a structure is.
- **Join / fix** – ways to attach materials together.
- **Base** – the bottom of a structure that helps it stand.

### R.E

In R.E, children will hear the story of the Road to Emmaus, the Ascension and the story of Pentecost. ### English

### Maths -Fractions

The whole is 12.

When finding thirds, the whole is shared into three equal parts.

The whole, 12, can be shared between 3 parts. There are 4 in each part.

When finding  $\frac{1}{3}$ , you will have one of the 3 parts.

Children will learn that fractions are equal parts of a whole. They will recognise and find  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{1}{4}$  of shapes, objects and numbers, practise sharing amounts into equal groups and understand that two quarters are the same as one half.

Children will also learn that fractions are equal parts of a whole. They recognise and find  $\frac{1}{3}$  and  $\frac{3}{4}$  of shapes, objects and amounts by dividing them into equal parts. They will also practise sharing quantities fairly and representing fractions using pictures, objects and numbers.

### How to Make a Jam Sandwich

## History

Children will learn about the events of the Great Fire of London in 1666, how it started and spread, its impact on the city and the changes it led to in firefighting and building safety.

### **Sticky Knowledge about the Great Fire of London**

- The fire spread very quickly because the houses were built very close to each other and made of wood.
- London was infested by rats and they were responsible for the plague.
- The type of fire appliances used in those days could not cope with the fire.
- The fire lasted for 4 days and destroyed large areas of London, making thousands of people homeless. It began on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 1666AD.
- A famous man called Samuel Pepys kept a diary of the events and that is one of the reasons we know about what happened.
- The fire started in a bakery in Pudding Lane in London. The bakery belonged to Thomas Farynor.

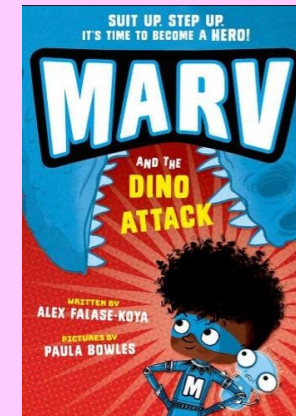


## RSE
