History

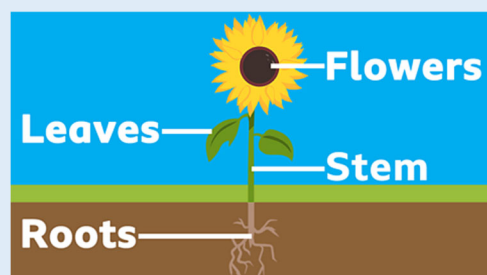
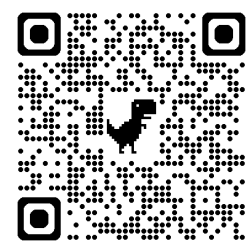
In history, we are looking at seaside holidays— these have changed a lot since the Victorian times! We still do some of the same activities.

We are learning about plants this term. We will be looking at the parts of a plant, how they grow and where they can grow.



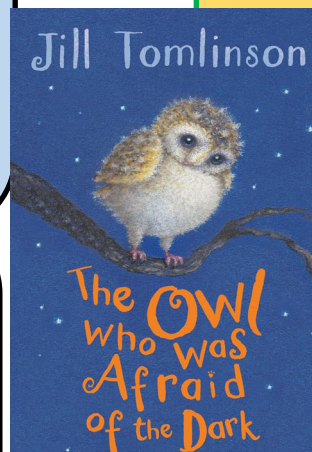

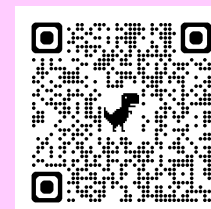

We are continuing to celebrate the Jubilee Year of hope!

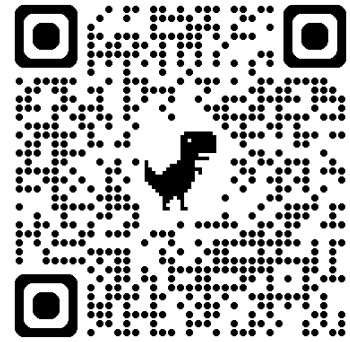
We will be recapping the events throughout Jesus' life, then exploring what happened after he was crucified.



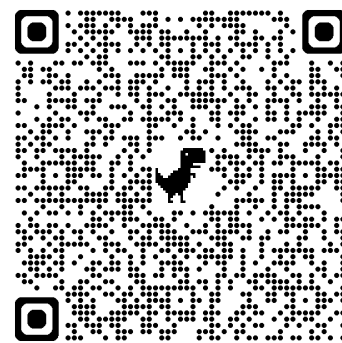

We will be beginning to work on multiplication and division! We will be focusing on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Have some fun and exercise together with BBC Supermovers!



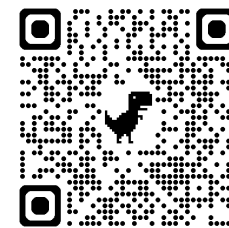

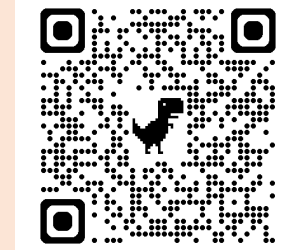

Phonics

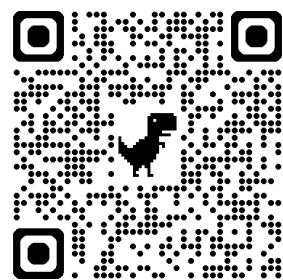
We are continuing to learn Set 2 and 3 sounds.

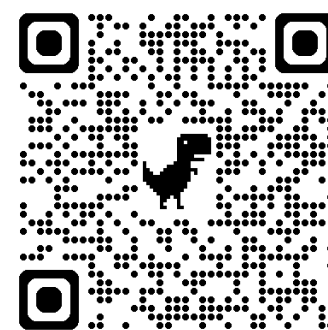
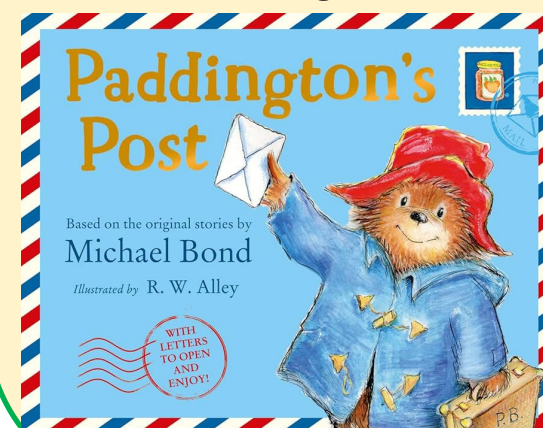


English
